## **The Town of Star Valley Ranch**

The final step in Wyoming statutes for incorporation is the official swearing in of the town officials. The ceremony is planned for Saturday, December 3, 2005 at 1:00 PM. Lincoln County Commissioner, Kent Connelly will be administering the oath, the Wyoming Speaker of the House, Randall Luthi, State Senator, Pat Aullman, WAM Executive Director, George Parks, SVRA Chairman of the Board, Jack Petty, and SVRA General Manager, Sharon Backus have all been invited to officially witness the administration of the oath.

As the Town of Star Valley Ranch continues to develop, let us all remember that the long-term partnership that was envisioned between the Town of Star Valley Ranch and the Star Valley Ranch Association is very desirable and necessary to ensure the financial future and quality of life for everyone. Your new town council and mayor, along with your current Board of Directors are dedicated to this concept.

**The Star Valley Ranch Association FISC's Round-up Project** This program is the same one we used last year. We encourage all members to "round up" when writing your check for your annual assessment to an even \$400, \$450, \$500.00 or more. The membership donated over \$10,000 last year for an average of about \$40.00 from those who contributed. We are hopeful you will exceed that this year.

The Funding Implementation Steering Committee (FISC) still has a lot left to do as we begin Phase Two of our mission. Phase Two will be completed with the successful transfer of SVRA's Culinary Water Distribution System and Road Maintenance from the Association to the Town. The FISC is the research, study and information gathering and distribution arm of the SVRA Board of Directors for this project.

It is estimated, to inform all the members of the various options and processes necessary to successfully transfer the assets and responsibilities for the water and roads from the Association to the town will take a considerable amount of funds. The FISC will use these funds for Water Expert's Advice, Legal Advice, Membership Information and Query Bulletins, recordings, etc., if necessary, to name just a few.

We ask everyone to please be generous as you round-up your annual assessment.
