

## **Highlights of Town Council Meeting - July 11, 2006**

Mayor Siddoway recognized the Old Fashioned 4th of July Committee for the many memorable activities. These included emotional Flag Raising and Flag Presentations, entertainment, meals, golf cart parade, and kids games and carnival. Although not sponsored by the Town, the town fully supports this activity.

People were again reminded of the importance of the Special U.S. Census that will commence on July 14, 2006.

A permanent, part time position of "Roads Superintendent" was established for the Town of Star Valley Ranch for the purpose of directing the day to day activities of the Town in matters pertaining to road maintenance. Mr. Warren Webb was selected as the first Roads Superintendent for the Town.

The Community Assessment for our community is being conducted July 10 through 12 by the Wyoming Rural Development Council. All persons were encouraged to attend and participate in the listening sessions and the feedback session at 7:00 PM on July 12.

Jan Jonson was appointed to the position of Town Councilman to fill out the remainder of the unexpired term that had been vacated by the resignation of Councilman Larry Lamb.

The Town of Star Valley Ranch approved a contribution of \$500 to the Star Valley Chamber of Commerce. The Chamber of Commerce supports and publicize many of the activities that take place on Star Valley Ranch.

A special Town Council meeting was held on June 27, 2006. The proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2006-2007 received it's third and final required reading and was passed.
