Fall of 2009 Water Line Construction

Impacted Roads Schedule

The Town will be letting bids for construction of two major water transmission lines for installation this fall.

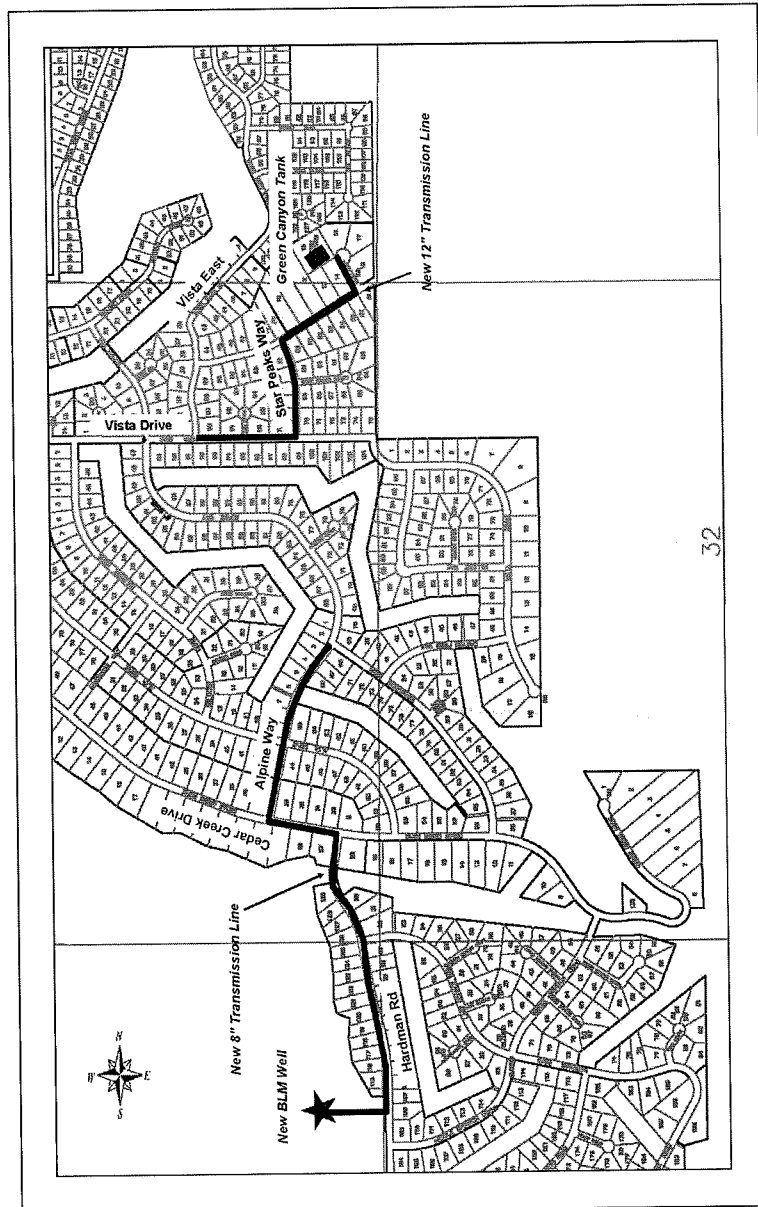
1. The WWDC – III line will provide the additional water supply from our new well on the BLM property into our distribution lines for the central part of Town. This line will also indirectly feed the Green Canyon Tank to increase water availability to residents in the lower two-thirds of the Town.

2. The Wyoming Business Council funded 12” transmission line will provide additional volumes of water from the Green Canyon Tank to the commercial area of Town. This will support the first legitimate “Fire Hydrants” in our Town as well as lay the foundation for additional fire protection to many of the residential areas in the future.

Please see the following page for more details as to the route and planned area of the pipe installations. Some changes may be necessary to accommodate and work around the existing installed utilities (phone, electricity and water).

Work should begin in late August or early September. Every effort will be made to accommodate “local” traffic and access to your property in the affected areas. We ask that you be patient with the construction and road crews as they perform their jobs. We anticipate the work to be completed this fall.

1. Wyoming Water Dev – III Grant (Phase I)

The new transmission line route will leave the BLM well / pump site just north of Middle Branch Road, extend north on the east side of Hardman to Cedar Creek Dr., continue west on the south side of Cedar Creek Dr. to Alpine Way, then north on the east side of Alpine Way to the intersection with Ridgcrest Drive.

2. Wyoming Business Council Grant – Infrastructure

The 12" transmission line will extend from the Green Canyon Tank vicinity west on the south side of Green Canyon Drive to Star Peaks Way, continue south on the east side of Star Peaks Way to Vista Drive, then west on the south side of Vista drive to the intersection with Vista East Drive.
