Frequently Asked Questions

1. I received a citation, what happens next?

You must appear in court at the date shown on the bottom of your citation unless otherwise advised in writing. If you fail to appear, a bench warrant for your arrest may be issued.

2. What happens when I appear in court?

Your initial appearance in court is for the sole purpose of entering your plea of guilty or not guilty. The court will advise you of your rights at that time.

3. What happens if I plead guilty?

If you plead guilty, the court will determine the sentence (fine) which you are required to pay at that time.

4. What happens if I plead not guilty?

If you plead not guilty, the court will set a date for a trial. At trial, the Town of Star Valley Ranch will present its case and you will present your case. At the end of the trial, the Judge will determine your innocence or guilt. If you are found guilty, the court will impose sentence (fine).

5. Can I have a lawyer?

Yes, you may have a lawyer represent you, at your own cost, at any stage of the proceedings.

6. Can I have witnesses?

Yes, you can have witnesses. The court will issue subpoenas, at your request, to compel witnesses to court, if necessary.
