Chapter 3 – Roads, Motor Vehicles and Traffic Control

Article 3 – Snow Removal

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN AMENDED ORDINANCE 2006-07, ARTICLE 3, SNOW REMOVAL, FOR THE TOWN OF STAR VALLEY RANCH, TO PROVIDE A MODIFICATION TO ARTICLE 3-03 AND ADD ARTICLE 3-06, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF 11/18/2008.

Article 3 – Snow Removal

Article 3-01 General

This Article is intended to compliment, supplement and reinforce Chapter 3, Article 2, Roads, regarding snow removal requirements and conditions at Star Valley Ranch, Wyoming.

Article 3-02 Right of Way

Snow removal vehicles and equipment shall be given priority consideration and regular traffic shall yield the right of way to this equipment at intersections and on roadways.

Article 3-03 Snow Removal Near Residences

When plowing snow from Town Roadways, the Town contractor or Town will, to the extent practicable, disperse snow evenly on both sides of the roadway. This will result in some snow from the roadway being deposited in driveways. Property owners shall not place snow removed from driveways or private property onto or across the plowed portions of the roadway.

Article 3-04 Property in Road Right of Way

Property owners should use extreme caution when placing trash containers or any property in the road right of way during winter conditions. Neither the Town nor the snow removal crews will be responsible for damage to improvements, vehicles or property that is in the road right of way and is damaged by snow removal operations. Any landscaping, vehicles, or property in the road right of way are placed there at the property owner's risk. This article does not modify or intend to modify any provision of Ordinance 2006-06, Article 2, Roads and persons placing property in the road right of way may be cited and/or the property impounded at the owners expense.

Article 3-05 Vehicle Parking

No vehicle may be parked on any roadway in the Town limits at any time. All contractor vehicles must park on private property.

Article 3-06 Violations

In all prosecutions for alleged violations of provisions of this article, the owner or resident of the property involved shall be prima facie presumed to have been the person removing snow at the time the offense was committed.
