Chapter 3 – Roads, Motor Vehicles and Traffic Control

Article 3 – Snow Removal

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A NEW CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 3, SNOW REMOVAL TO THE TOWN OF STAR VALLEY RANCH CODE THAT REPLACES ORDINANCE 2006-07, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 3, SNOW REMOVAL IN ITS ENTIRETY, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF 11/11/2009.

Article 3 – Snow Removal

Article 3-01 General

This Article is intended to compliment, supplement and reinforce Chapter 3, Article 2, Roads, regarding snow removal requirements and conditions at Star Valley Ranch, Wyoming.

Article 3-02 Right of Way

Snow removal vehicles and equipment shall be given priority consideration and regular traffic including pedestrian traffic shall yield the right of way to this equipment at all intersections and on all roadways.

Article 3-03 Snow Removal Near Residences

Property owners shall not place snow removed from driveways or private property onto or across the plowed portions of the roadway.

Incident to clearing snow from private property, driveways or ends of driveways; property owners, residents or their agents are prohibited from leaving berms or piles of ice, snow or slush on the traveled portion of any roadway in a manner that could hamper the safe and orderly flow of two way traffic on town roadways, or that could hamper the safe and orderly flow of traffic on one way split roads.

Property owners, residents or their agents are prohibited at all times from placing snow, by any means, against the roadside opposite or across from the property from which the snow is being removed.

Article 3-04 Property in Road Right of Way

Property owners should use extreme caution when placing trash containers or any property in the road right of way during winter conditions. Trash containers should be

placed in the owner's driveway near the center of the drive, yet back toward the house far enough to be off the road right of way and on private property where appropriate. Neither the Town nor the snow removal crews will be responsible for damage to improvements, vehicles or property that is in the road right of way and is damaged by snow removal operations. Any landscaping, vehicles, or property in the road right of way are placed there at the property owner's risk.

This article does not modify or intend to modify any provision of Ordinance 2006-06, Article 2, Roads and persons placing property in the road right of way may be cited and/or the property impounded at the owner's expense.

No vehicle may be parked on any roadway in the Town limits at any time. All contractor vehicles must park on private property.

Article 3-05 Violations

In all prosecutions for alleged violations of provisions of this article, the owner or resident of the property involved shall be prima facie presumed to have been the person removing snow at the time the offense was committed.
