Resolution No. 06-10-17-001

RESOLUTION authorizing submission of a Federal Mineral Royalty Capital Construction Account Grant Application to the State Land and Investment Board on behalf of the governing body of the Town of Star Valley Ranch for the purpose of purchasing and installing approximately 150 reflective “street name” signs at all intersections within the Town:

WHEREAS the governing body of the Town of Star Valley Ranch desires to participate in the FEDERAL MINERAL ROYALTY CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION ACCOUNT GRANT program to assist in financing this project, and

WHEREAS the governing body of the Town of Star Valley Ranch recognizes the need for the project, and

WHEREAS the Federal Mineral Royalty Capital Construction Account Grant program requires that certain criteria be met, as described in the State Land and Investment Board’s Rules and Regulations governing the program, and to the best of our knowledge this application meets those criteria, and

WHEREAS the governing body of the Town of Star Valley Ranch plans to match the requested Federal Mineral Royalty Capital Construction Account Grant from the following source(s): the Town’s Capital Equipment Reserve as allocated within Ordinance No. 2006-03, Appropriations for Fiscal Year 2006-2007 (adopted June 27, 2006).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the Town of Star Valley Ranch that a grant application in the amount of \$21,150.00 be submitted to the State Land and Investment Board for consideration at the November 16, 2006 Grant Meeting to assist in funding the Reflective “Street Name” Signs project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mayor Boyd Siddoway is hereby designated as the authorized

representative of the Town of Star Valley Ranch to act on behalf of the Governing Body on all matters relating to this grant application.
